B. Carson Park RFP (2025-362)

Since the October GVAHC meeting, the Carson Park RFP was reviewed by an external Public Art Coordinator, and her suggestions were added to the final draft of the RFP. Cultural Arts Manager Lisa Neeper went over the updates, which included language specifying that the proposed artwork must be a sculpture (as opposed to a mural, another common "permanent, outdoor" art form), and a firmer timeline with set dates. The Arts Council members were reminded that the selection process will require multiple additional/elongated meetings with the group, which will be held starting at 4:30PM on the same day as the regularly-scheduled GVAHC meetings coming up in February, March and April of 2026.

C. Financial Summary Report (2025-365)

Cultural Arts Manager Lisa Neeper shared the updated Financial Summary Report, noting income from considerable art sales in the most recent show.

D. Community Events Calendar (2025-364)

The Arts Council went over the Community Events Calendar, with an emphasis on the current Curtis Creates show, and Curtis Center closures in January and February 2026 for renovations.
